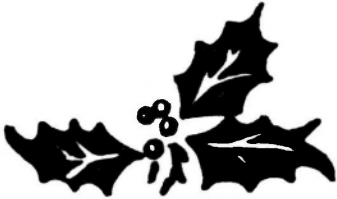

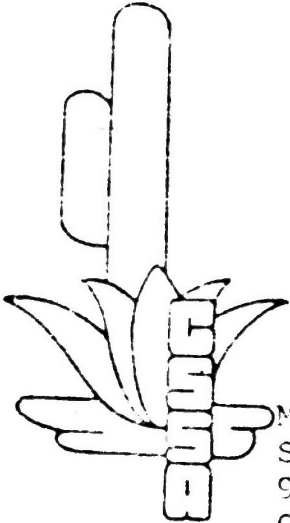
XMAS PLANT DRAWING - NOTICE TO PREFERRED TICKET MEMBERS


